



Tackling Corona Crisis

Food support, online teaching, waterfilters and face-masks.



Application and agreement:

Since the Corona Virus ruled our health, but even more the economic situation of many people in Bali, Stichting Kolewa (the Netherlands), and Yayasan Kolewa Harapan Indonesia started fundraising to enable the distribution of food supply and more.

With a part of the gathered funds, we knocked on the door of "Wilde Ganzen" for extra help. We are grateful for all donations and the added amount on top of the Wilde Ganzen Foundation.

In this overview, we inform all donors about our emergency program for Balinese inhabitants, affected by the current situation around Covid-19. We started the distribution of food parcels in April 2020 and will be hopefully able to continue this until the end of the year, or even longer if needed.

We received the shown donation on the Yayasan Kolewa Harapan Indonesia's bank account 1450011912793 on Thursday 25th June 2020, 584.026.615 IDR. We confirmed on 26th June that project number 2020.0403 would start from Saturday, 27 June 2020.

Donations before and after June, labeled for emergency help were received on the account of Stichting Kolewa Holland and transferred to the Yayasan regularly.

The total budget raised for this program in the Netherlands and Indonesia, from the start in March until 15th October is € 65.000, which enables us to continue until 1 Dember 2020.

The start!

Yayasan Kolewa Harapan Indonesia started to distribute "Sembako", the Indonesian word for food-packs, mid April. This thanks to earlier donations from April until June that enabled us to give away over 1000 parcels.

What do they get per average family once in two weeks?

Rice, oil, coffee, eggs, noodles, onions, garlic, sugar, chili, milk-powder, carrots, cabbage, Labu (local vegetables), dried fish, Tempe, toothpaste and soap or detergent and sometimes an extra treat like cakes or cookies. All in a re-usable Kolewa bag. And of course we provide face-mask and waterfilters for those who need it.



Behind the screen...



We order all as much as we can at local suppliers. Together with the team we divide the goods per family.



Seasoning, Balinese people use it in every meal... so we make sure they receive some spices to follow tradition.



In total we ordered 125 waterfilters that found their way to families in need, between July and September.

Rice is the most important part of the local food in Indonesia. Usually eaten three times a day: breakfast, lunch and dinner if available.

You can imagine that if people ask for help, in fact, they ask for rice!

Kolewa Foundation is usually teaching people, through several outreach-programs, about healthy and nutritious food, vitamins and using less sugar, and the importance of hygiene.

Therefore our food-packs contain besides 10-kilo rice also vegetables, fish, Tempe, eggs, soap, toothpaste, detergent, and face masks for protection.



Special masks for Kolewa's deaf children

One of our regular projects is the care for children with a hearing problem in Bali. Our foundation provides access to hearing-tests, hearing-aid, speech-therapy, and sign-language lessons. We have several groups in Karangasem and Denpasar. Besides that, we offer daily transportation to 18 children to join the deaf-school in the city and pay for the school fee and curriculum. During the Corona period 32 children joined online classes, thanks to your donation for phone-credit (internet).

For all these kids we purchased special face-masks. For all other Indonesian family-members, we ordered masks with a Kolewa logo and distributed them together with the food-packs.

Total: 2500 masks produced by the staff and (deaf) students of Catur Training Centre, our field-partner.



Distribution 125 waterfilters in a few months!



The profits of a water filter:

turn rain- or river water into clean drinking water.

No need to cook water anymore, so people save gas or wood.

Do not have to buy bottled water, saving money.

Online teaching because schools are closed!

Children with a hearing problem.

Communication in a different way that's what we needed to implement as soon as the schools closed in Bali. Our team prepared every week online lessons, using our smart-tv and WhatsApp to communicate with our deaf Kolewa-kids at home.


To make sure this all kids got access, we did send their parents on a regular basis phone credit.

- 👉 we communicate in sign language
- 👉 we teach about daily life topics
- 👉 we give them assignments
- 💪 parents help them at home
- ✍️ they get homework for the next days

There are group lessons, but also personal contact online to guide the children and encourage them in difficult corona times. All kids miss meeting their friends and as a team we do miss them a lot.
