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Mission and Vision.

Our motive: Physically disabled or limited children have a right to a decent and promising life. They should be able to grow up just like any other child. The Kolewa Foundation contributes to this goal by offering medical help and fitting education. We want to prevent that these children get isolated and neglected, and have to grow up without proper education, as a result of their disability or the way they look. These children should have a chance to participate in home and school activities as much as possible and not be abandoned at school. They are part of the community!

What we do: We bring change to the lives of children with medical issues. Our approach is unique; we take care of the child's entire 'medical trip'. This includes medical examinations, (often relatively easy) surgery and providing medicines. During this medical trip, we try to make things as fun as possible for the children. For children with hearing disabilities, we provide special education, sign language classes and speech therapy. Our work area covers all the islands of Indonesia. Our patient companions go to pick up patients from other islands. Before and after the surgery, the patients and their companions stay in our shelter 'Rumah Bicara' in Denpasar, the capital of Bali. After a final check at the hospital, we take the children back to their homes. We provide follow-up care in the form of check-ups, additional support and periodic 'family gatherings' where we reunite with the children and their companions. We also try to prevent diseases by giving poor families access to clean drinking water through our water filtering project. We work to improve self-confidence, the feeling of belonging and daring the children to interact with others. We also work on improving the communication between parent and child. We stimulate the development of the children by offering all kinds of activities and lessons. We provide information about a healthy lifestyle and hygiene. Most of these children have very bad teeth, so before the procedure, a visit to a dentist is often required.

Our target groups: We focus on children from families on the most isolated and poorest islands in Indonesia. Due to the lack of adequately equipped hospitals and available specialists, good medical care is often not available. The patient's families often don't have the financial means to make the trip to Bali. The medical focus is on children born with cleft lip, cleft palate, hearing problems or serious disfigurations due to burns. We also help children with anal atresia, spina bifida or hydrocephalus, among others. We provide aid for approximately 200 children per year.

How do we do this: Committed and result-oriented. We are a small organization, that is our strength. Our commitment allows us to act quickly. We can skip the lengthy procedures and start working right away. We are creative in finding solutions and will continue until we succeed, which means that we can quickly achieve a positive result. That is exactly what appeals to the sponsors and friends of the Kolewa Foundation. They are enthusiastic about our approach, which enables us to make major changes in the lives of these children.

Sustainable cooperation

Yayasan Kolewa Harapan is run by an enthusiastic and professional local team under the guidance of the board and the founder. There is a close relationship with counterpart Stichting Kolewa from The Netherlands who in particular helps with fundraising and shares important knowledge with us.

The stable network of our Indonesian field partners is indispensable. We consider it important to have longterm cooperation with various institutions for eye and hearing problems, speech therapy and rehabilitation. This enables us to contribute to the sustainable improvement of the local health care system. We work together with local scouts on the various islands. Yearly we do receive regular support from student trainees and volunteers from universities and higher professional education from The Netherlands and other countries guided by teammember Holdin Nitti.

Training

Two board members of Yayasan Kolewa Harapan Indonesia was given the opportunity to travel twice to Yogyakarta organized by Yayasan SatuNama and Wilde Ganzen from the Netherlands. As a charity foundation we are depending on a large number of donations from abroad. Our goal however is to become more independent in future and to expend our network. We are seeking to grow and become even more impactful in Indonesia, our homecountry. There are many aspects of fundraising and foundation management the board and team likes to explore. In 2023 we gave it a start by using the crowdfunding platform Kita Bisa and try to target the right audience who align with our foundation's mission and values.

In order to get a stronger self-esteem during presentations and meetings which are held in English, tree member do follow English classes among at higher level in speaking and writing.

Success in the non-profit sector requires a combination of passion, strategic planning, effective execution and continuous improvement. By focussing on these key areas our organization want to achieve greater impact and make a lasting difference in the lives of who we serve in a more independent way in terms of income from abroad.















Fundraising in Indonesia

Two board members started after their training in Yogyakarta by Yayasan Satuama a local fundraiser. In collaboration with ACK Fried Chicken Bali and printed 1000 coupons to exchange with a meal.


The price per coupon was 40.000 idr, our profit was 20.000 idr per meal. The entire team was able to sell 850 coupons in a short time to family and friends, to field partners and also asked the parents of the kids in our deaf-project to assist selling! Some vouchers were bought by Kolewafriends without self-interest. They asked us to distribute their meal to the poor people in the streets from Denpasar.











Kita Bisa: is an Indonesian crowdfunding platform that allows organizations like Kolewa to raise money. The platform was designed to be user-friendly and accessible to people of all backgrounds. With some assistance of the Kita Bisa advertisement group we started 4 opportunities for people to donate in 2023. Kita Bisa looks like a powerful tool that we do hope to use again next year in order to get more awareness and money for our projects in Indonesia.

Children with cleft lip or an open palate have problems on different levels: eating does not go well, which causes them to be underweight. Frequently they have dental problems which make it harder to speak. A (relatively) easy surgery can give these children the chance to have a healthy and independent life!

We scout potential child patients as well as young-adults and transport them (and their guiding family member) to Bali for surgery and further treatment. Our patients do come from all different parts of Indonesia. During treatment, the children and their guardian stay temporary in our shelter Rumah Bicara during their medical journey. Our partner-hospitals are Dharma Yadnya Hospital and Bali Royal Hospital and Bali Mandara Hospital.. All children had a Dutch personal sponsor for a part of the traveling and hosting in collaboration with our counterpart

Stichting Kolewa. The procedures for presurgery dental care and hospitalization were financially supported by a Global grant of the The Rotary Foundation under the execution of Rotary Club Bali Nusa Dua. In 2023 our Yayasan offered 137 children a lifechanging medical journey. Rumah Bicara is the home base of Yayasan Kolewa, a building with multiple functions. Because we were frequently running out of space we opened a second location "Kolewa-Gang" in Jalan Pulau Sebatik. One of the most important things is that we, since september 2023, can give shelter to 26 patients in total guided each by one family member. Wound care and health-checks were carried out daily. Two of our staff members live permanent in the new "Kolawa-gang". The location where we build a new central kitchen.

Rumah Bicara is the place where we gather as a team for meetings and welcome foreign

and local visitors to tell them about our charity program and daily activities. During the week we offer all our temporary inhabitants three meals a day, an activity program, home-schooling and for children with CLP or a hearing problem speech therapy and sign language lessons. For parents we have a sign language program twice a week. The whole year we teach deaf children in sign language and organized educational training for the staff. Hygienerules were highly respected by our concierge Mr. Klement and housekeeper Heldi.







In September we opened a second location with 6 extra rooms, a storage, a wash place and a small house for our concierge and kitchen chef. In the last semester we renovated, next to our Kolewa gang the old warung te become a central kitchen for both locations.



Special support to former patients and families in need:

Ingky, living in Kupang Timor, is our former burns patient; we offered him a scholarship in Kupang at the University: for agriculture.

Patrick, again a victim of a burn-accident living in Kupang, has also a severe eye-problem. He needed new glasses to be able to perform good in school.

The family of Angel, a girl with spina bifida in Kupang, needed in 2023 financially support for transportation to the SLB-school en buying special diapers to solve her incontinentie problem. She is using a wheelchair, also donated by our Yayasan.

We supported Ketut living in Ubud Bali, and his family in several ways: they needed new batteries for their electric wheelchair, food support and assistance in selling their handmade jewelry and chips.

We have given our local scout Rian (Kupang, Timor) the change to get more education, starting with English classes.

Kasianus, 15 years old from Flores, underwent drastic and complicated plastic surgery in the Sanglah Hospital.

Regular support to the blood bank in Bali







Yearly we join, on a regular base, the blood bank meetings on location. We provide the blood donors with a healthy meal to quickly regain strength and to thank therefor their efforts. One of our Dutch interns also donated her blood.

The Dinas Social board kindly requested to help this people in need end October 2023. The whole team worked with a smile together to bring a healthy meal, we are always willing to help if it is in our power and financially feasible.









Using sign language for communication changes their lives, but first, we test hearing loss carefully! A large group (over hundred) of kids and parents is already following our program for years.

In Denpasar, not far from Rumah Bicara (the Kolewa location), Lumina Hearing Center is located. With sufficient facilities for testing young children, this is a convenient address for our patients with a hearing problem. During our outreach activities in Bali, we regularly detect children with a hearing problem. In those cases, we offer help and free hearing test in Denpasar.

Most children and parents that knock on our door are in need of special education. The kids do live an isolated life and don't go to school. If parents do use the possibility of free testing and devices we offer, they agree to let their child take part in our speech therapy and sign language program, every weekend. Parents also endorse the intention to acquire knowledge themselves and to practice sign language to be able to communicate better with their deaf child.

In 2023 we continued a special training for parents in Denpasar (22) and Karangasem (27) twice a week. The enthusiasm of the participants is overwhelming and leads to great progress in their communication at home with their deaf or bad hearing child.

Since 2023 we rent during the weekend some classrooms in the SMP 3 Rendang school in Batusesa, Karangasem, to teach on locations. Our team is going there weekly to teach sign language with one of the Kolewa-cars driven by Wayan or Komang.













Twenty-one Kolewa-children with a hearing problem do go daily to the Sushrusa deaf school in Denpasar for special education, given in sign-language. Our driver Komang is bringing them to school and back home with our schoolbus. Two times per week they also come to our shelter home for extra lessons and a healthy meal. The Sushrusa Deaf School offers besides Kindergarten and Elementary school since 2022 also the Junior High School. Although the most crucial focus is on education and development, the school also cares that the pupils can enjoy different topics like gardening, dancing, pantomime, computer lessons, modeling, and cooking. It is great to see the growth of the children, their enthusiasm, and their eagerness to learn. We love to see them perform and invite them during our events to show their talent.



In 2023 we could organize three family gatherings, one in Sumba and two other in Bali. (visit to the Zoo and the launching of the new sign-language booklet). These yearly events do have several objectives: monitoring children who have been in our care for a long time because their disability or surgery, sharing concerns and experiences, educational activities and teambuilding for kids and their parents.







In Sumba we called back 36 patients that had surgery on their cleft lip or palate before or who needed a bone graft operation in Bali. Our team checked the results, gave seminars to their parents and offered a refresher course of speech therapy. The gathering was located in a hotel in Tambolaka and lasted two days. All was arranged by the Kolewa board, team and interns, including food and transportation. At the end it appeared that 13 children needed to come to Bali in 2024 for a second surgery.














In total we visited 174 families that don't have acces to clean drinking water in tree area's. 47 Complete sets in Nusa Penida, 42 sets lombok and 32 sets Bali in Karangasem and Buleleng area. Besides that we made unannounced home visits to families who had previously received a waterfilter. We were satisfied to see that most of these people use the filter in the right way. For those who were using the filter alsmost two years we changed 53 candles in Bali.

Visitors came now and than to bring to our shelter home a donation or we were invited to a hotel or restaurant in Bali to empty the money box at their reception.














Donations 2023

During the year 2023, we received, per semester, support from our counterpart Stichting Kolewa in Holland. These donations are raised through fundraising activities in The Netherlands and enabled us to continue our charity program. Additional funds from Rotary Club Bali Nusa Dua covered partly the expenses for hosting CLP-patients and transportation to the hospital. In the second part of the year we enlarged our hosting-capacity by opening a second location, close to our shelter-home on the Jalan Pulau Sebatik in Denpasar. By offering more patients a temporary place to stay we also had to expand the car-fleet and the central kitchen!

One 01 January 2023 we started the year with a destination reserve of 3.155.305.069 IDR. In 2023 throughout the year our Yayasan received in total an amount of 4.714.978.397 IDR, containing the support of our counterpart Stichting Kolewa, donations from visitors and the additional financial support from Rotary Club Bali Nusa Dua in our cleft lip & palate project. We got 50.429.679 IDR interest on our savings. Our total expenditure to realized all projects, was 4.225.380.530 IDR, including realizing a second location, central kitchen and extra car for patient-transportation and two more staff-members. We could add a positive result of 489.597.867 IDR to our destination reserve. In addition to this short-term reservation, for the total of the destination reserve 2024 - 2030 we also take into account future costs for purposes such as maintenance of Rumah Bicara, extension of the rental contract for 5 to 10 years, replacement of the means of transport, computers and phones for our organization as well as an emergency fund in case of sudden natural disasters in Bali.


Closing word from Chair, Ibu
